NOVEMBER, 2010, BALLOT QUESTION

SHALL OURAY COUNTY REGIONAL SERVICE AUTHORITY (“RSA”) TAXES BE INCREASED BY \$52,596.65 ANNUALLY, OR SUCH LESSER AMOUNT AS THE RSA BOARD OF DIRECTORS MAY ANNUALLY DETERMINE, BASED UPON THE 2009 ASSESSED VALUATION FOR OURAY COUNTY, BY A MAXIMUM AD VALORUM MILL LEVY OF 1/4 (.25) MILL EACH YEAR FOR TEN (10) YEARS, COMMENCING IN THE YEAR 2011, FOR THE PROVISION OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO THE CITIZENS OF OURAY COUNTY, COLORADO, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE RSA MEDICAL FACILITY LOCATED IN RIDGWAY, COLORADO, TOGETHER WITH THE ACQUISITION AND MAINTENANCE OF SUCH EQUIPMENT AS MAY BE NEEDED TO REASONABLY OPERATE SAID FACILITY.
- THE CONDUCT OF SUCH STUDIES AND EVALUATIONS AS THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL REASONABLY DETERMINE NECESSARY IN ORDER TO ASSESS THE ADEQUACY OF THE CURRENT AND FUTURE PROVISION OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES AND WHETHER ADDITIONAL FACILITIES AND/OR SERVICES ARE REQUIRED.
